BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 075-2023

A By-law to amend the Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, to prohibit vehicles from stopping on Cold Creek Road from Nashville Road to King Vaughan Road at any time.

WHEREAS section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the “*Municipal Act*”) provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS section 11(3) and 11(8) of the *Municipal Act* provide for lower-tier municipalities to pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways;

AND WHEREAS section 100.1 of the *Municipal Act* provides that local municipality may, in respect of land not owned or occupied by the municipality, regulate or prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles without the consent of the owner of the land;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan deems the regulation of parking necessary to ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians, the effective flow of traffic, and the maintenance of community standards;

AND WHEREAS the City has determined that vehicles are stopping on Cold Creek Road and impacting the two-way traffic flow due to insufficient lane width, and that a stopping prohibition on both sides of the street could improve traffic flow and improve safety;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Parking By-law 064-2019, as amended, Schedule 3, is amended to the add the following row in alphabetical order:
