## Water Service Interruption — Woodbridge Avenue and surrounding area

**Sunday, Aug. 13 to Monday Aug. 14, 2023**

To undertake sanitary sewer repairs on Woodbridge Avenue, water service to the local area will be temporarily shutdown to complete essential components of the work. To minimize the impacts to residents and businesses, this work is being scheduled over night on the following dates and times:

**Date: Starting on Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, from 9:00 pm to Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 am, water service interruptions will be implemented for the following locations as specified below:**

<u>137, 145, 153, 159, 165, and 167 Woodbridge Avenue</u>	<b>Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 9:00 pm to 7:00 am on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023</b>
<u>124 Woodbridge Avenue (Big Cannoli) and 150 Woodbridge Avenue (Woodbridge Library)</u>	<b>Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 9:00 pm to 7:00 am on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023</b>
<u>154, 160, 166, and 174 Woodbridge Avenue</u>	<b>Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 9:00 pm to 7:00 am on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023</b>
<u>207, 209, 211, 213, 215, 217, 219 Woodbridge Avenue and 7, 9, 11, 15, 17, 19, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45, 47 Old Fire Hall Lane (Old Fire Hall Lane Subdivision)</u>	<b>Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 9:00 pm to 7:00 am on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023</b>

### What you need to know:

- If you have a fire protection and alarm system, you will need to notify your monitoring company of the planned shut-down.
- Prior to the interruption of water service, please draw sufficient water into containers for use during this period or make other necessary arrangements. You may need to adjust your service hours or close your business to comply with Public Health and Ministry of Labour regulations.
- When testing to see if the water is back on, check the **cold-water tap**. If the water is on, allow it to flow for a few minutes until it runs clear.
- It is suggested that you **avoid** turning on the hot water tap during a water service interruption to prevent damage to the building's water heaters.

This work is being carried out by the City-retained contractor, Four Season Site Development Limited, under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.
