Improvements are coming

The City of Vaughan will be replacing various culverts along Kipling Avenue as part of the 2023 Capital Works Program.

What is a culvert?


Culverts are large tunnels that allow stormwater to flow under roadways and pathways.

Construction scope

The work will include:

- removal and replacement of the corrugated steel pipe (CSP) culvert on Kipling Avenue, 0.7 kilometres north of Teston Road.
- removal of the CSP culvert on Kipling Avenue,
 1.5 kilometres north of Teston Road and replacement with a concrete box culvert.
- removal and replacement of the concrete box culvert on Kipling Avenue, 0.6 kilometres north of Kirby Road.
- removal and replacement of the CSP culvert on King Vaughan Road, west of Kipling Avenue, and installation of new stone retaining walls.

These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring the long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.



Impacts

Impacts to the local community will include road closures along Kipling Avenue, north of Teston Road and south of King Vaughan Road. Kipling Avenue will remain accessible to local traffic at all times. Detours will be put in place as needed to convey traffic around the closures.

Construction timelines

Construction is underway and is anticipated to be complete by the end of December 2023.
