Temporary road closure: Woodbridge Avenue, from 7960 Kipling Ave. to the intersection at Kipling Avenue and Woodbridge Avenue

A temporary road closure will be in place on Woodbridge Avenue, from 7960 Kipling Ave. to the intersection at Woodbridge Avenue and Kipling Avenue, **starting tonight at 6 p.m., Friday, Sept. 15, until 6 a.m. on Monday, Sept. 18**. Access to homes on Woodbridge Avenue and the Nino D'Aversa Bakery (7960 Kipling Ave.) will be maintained.

What you need to know:

- Eastbound traffic on Woodbridge Avenue will be re-directed to Martin Grove Road and westbound traffic towards Kipling Avenue will be re-directed to Langstaff Road.
- Access to homes on Woodbridge Avenue will not be impacted.
- Access to Nino D'Aversa Bakery at 7960 Kipling Ave. will be maintained.

The City of Vaughan is undertaking this work as part of the Woodbridge Avenue Improvements and Streetscaping Project, which includes watermain replacements, sanitary sewer enhancements and road upgrades. In addition to the underground infrastructure work, the City is also restructuring the road, providing additional on-street parking, upgrading traffic signals, updating the street lighting and walkways, and adding new streetscaping and landscaping features.

This work is being carried out by the City-retained contractor, Four Seasons Site Development Limited, under the direction of the City's Infrastructure Delivery department.
