# Land Acknowledgement

We respectfully acknowledge that the City of Vaughan is situated in the Territory and Treaty 13 lands of the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation. The City of Vaughan initiated a Streetscape Master Plan Study for Islington Avenue and Nashville Road within the Village of Kleinburg. This study reviewed the historical, natural, and contemporary context, and identified Kleinburg character zones within the village core and surrounding area. The Streetscape Master Plan Study final report was completed and accepted by Vaughan Council in 2011.







# Kleinburg Village Improvements


The City is undertaking the Kleinburg Village Improvements Project to provide enhancements and ensure municipal infrastructure can continue to support the community for years to come.

The project area extends along Islington Avenue from Major Mackenzie Drive to Highway 27, along Nashville Road from Highway 27 to Islington Avenue, and along Stegman's Mill Road from Islington Avenue to Teston Road.





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



### Managing Construction Impacts

Construction impacts and traffic interruption is to be expected. The following is a list of measures that will be implemented to mitigate impact:

- Temporary removal of on-street parking to maintain two-way traffic along Islington Avenue through the Village Core
- Temporary parking facility will be provided on Islington Avenue north of Nashville Road
- Provisions for pedestrian safety accommodation on both sides of Islington Avenue
- Businesses will remain accessible by the public throughout construction
- Driveways will remain accessible at all time
- Temporary streetlighting within the village core
- Watermain replacement on a block-by-block basis

- Night work will be needed for watermain work within middle of Islington Avenue/Stegman's Mill Road intersection
- Nashville Road will be reduced to single lane westbound for watermain work
- Islington Avenue will be reduced to single lane northbound between Nashville Road and Highway 27 for watermain work after completion of the Nashville Road watermain work
- Measures for continued municipal service (garbage collection, snow plowing) will be provided
- Lay-by parking will be temporally removed only when needed to facilitate construction














### Lay-by Parking:


Pavement enhancement to differentiate and harmonize with pedestrian zone Barrier curbs for safety
