



# New Westminster Drive road rehabilitation and improvements project

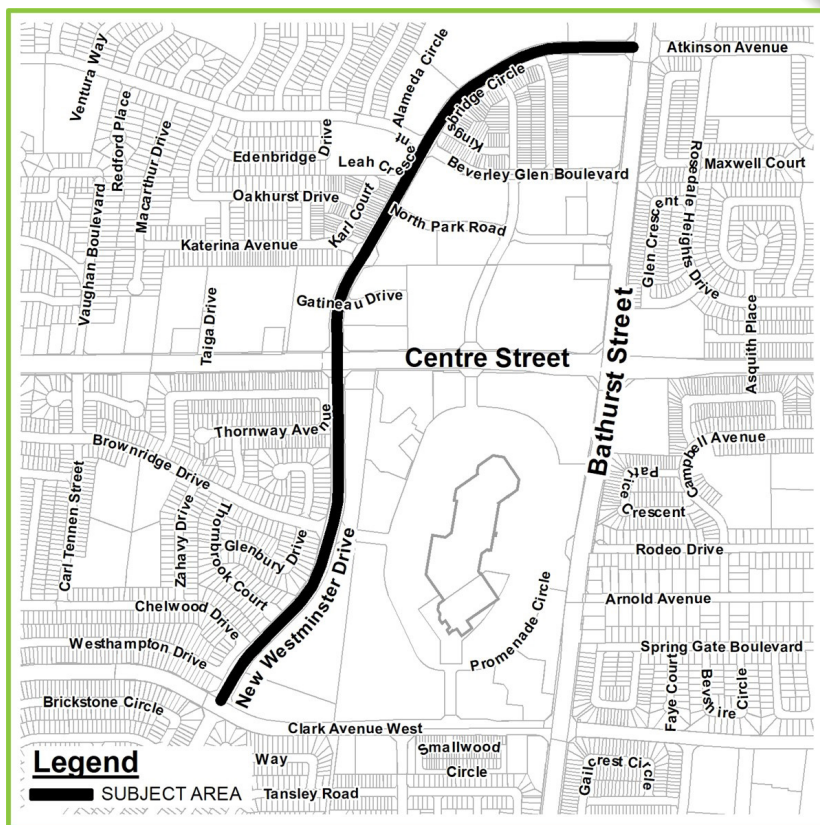


The City of Vaughan is undertaking important infrastructure improvements on New Westminster Drive from Bathurst Street to Clark Avenue. These improvements include:

- road resurfacing.
- a new signalized mid-block pedestrian crossing.
- upgrading existing lighting infrastructure.
- replacing sidewalk segments and upgrading crossings to meet accessibility standards.
- upgrading transit stops with bus pads.
- upgrading existing signalized mid-block pedestrian crossings.
- upgrading two signalized intersections.
- construction of new in-boulevard cycle tracks.

These enhancements will further support the City's commitment to improve transportation and mobility as well as long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure assets.

Construction is scheduled to begin by the end of September 2023 and is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2024.



## Construction impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.
