

Canada Drive-America Avenue Bridge

Dear resident or landowner,

The City of Vaughan is building a bridge over Highway 400 to connect Canada Drive and America Avenue. This new bridge will enhance Vaughan's transportation network and help alleviate traffic, allowing you to travel seamlessly from one community to another.

Project update

In July 2023, the City awarded the contract to EllisDon Civil Ltd. to undertake the detailed design and construction of the bridge. The contractor is in the process of planning the early works of construction activities, which will commence in mid-October. Early works include:

- installing erosion and sediment control measures.
- removing trees and implementing tree protection measures.
- stripping and excavating existing topsoil.
- importing, placing and compacting fill materials (e.g. soil and gravel) to the site.



Timelines

Construction of the bridge is scheduled to begin in 2024 and is anticipated to be complete by 2026.

Construction impacts

All roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will be required to allow construction activities to be undertaken in a safe and efficient manner.
