## BY-LAW

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 200-2023**

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan to amend the Short-Term Rental By-law 158-2019, as amended, to transfer the authority to appoint Hearing Officers to the City Clerk.

**WHEREAS** Section 8(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001*, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly as to confer broad authority on a municipality to (a) enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate, and (b) enhance its ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Vaughan considers it appropriate that the City Clerk be delegated the authority to appoint Hearing Officers under the Administrative Monetary Penalties system;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law 158-2019, as amended, be amended by adding the definition of City Clerk, to Section 3.0 'Definitions and Interpretation', in alphabetical order, as follows:
  - "City Clerk" means the person appointed by Council as Clerk pursuant *to* Section 228 of the Municipal Act, 2001, or their designate."
- 2. That By-law 158-2019, as amended, be further amended by deleting the definition of "Hearings Officer" contained in Section 3.0 (1)(I) 'Definitions and Interpretation' and replacing as follows:
  - ""Hearings Officer" means a Person from time to time appointed to such role by the City Clerk."
