BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 201-2023

A By-law to amend Fence By-law 189-2020, as amended, to transfer the authority to appoint Hearing Officers to the City Clerk.

WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (“Municipal Act, 2001”), provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS subsection 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 7 of subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting Structures, including Fences and Signs;

AND WHEREAS the City of Vaughan considers it appropriate that the City Clerk be delegated the authority to appoint Hearing Officers under the Administrative Monetary Penalties system;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 189-2020, as amended, be amended by adding the definition of City Clerk, to Section 3.0 ‘Definitions and Interpretation’ as follows:

“City Clerk” means the person appointed by Council as Clerk pursuant to Section 228 of the Municipal Act, 2001, or their designate.”
2. That By-law 189-2020, as amended, be amended by replacing the words “*Director of By-law and Compliance, Licensing and Permit Services or their successor*”, with “City Clerk” in the definition of “Hearings Officer”, contained in Section 3.0 ‘Definitions and Interpretation’.
