ELIGIBILITY:

- 13 years of age or older and currently attending an Ontario secondary school
- Able to complete a timed 400 meter swim screening test in 11 minutes or less

COURSE CONTENT

Students will be evaluated throughout the course with written assignments, quizzes, projects, and presentations. Final examinations include a written and technical portion as required by the Lifesaving Society and Ministry of Education.

To receive a credit, students must meet Ministry of Education course expectations. Passing all Lifesaving Society portions of the course alone does not guarantee a course credit.

SAFETY

There will be a supervision ratio of 1 certified Teacher/Aquatic instructor and 1 certified lifeguard on deck or in the pool.

Students must pass the initial screening/test to participate in the course.
