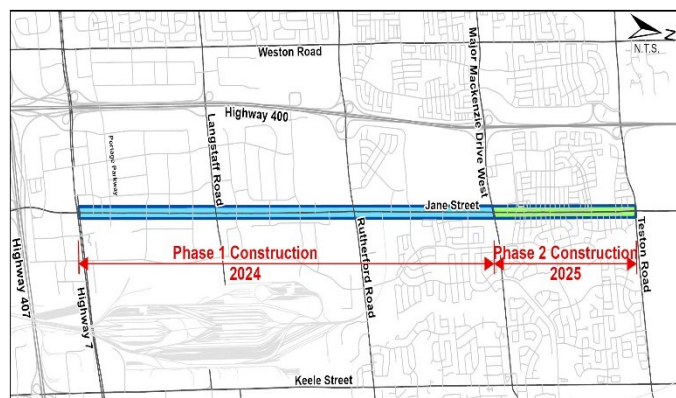
Dear resident or business owner,

Vaughan is home to a large active transportation network of sidewalks, cycle tracks and bike lanes – and it continues to grow. As part of the City of Vaughan's **Jane Street Uptown Link Project**, new in-boulevard cycle tracks and sidewalk and streetlight enhancements are coming to Jane Street, from Highway 7 to Teston Road.

Timelines

The project roll out will take place over two phases. Phase one of the project, along Jane Street, from Highway 7 to Major Mackenzie Drive, is scheduled to be tendered in Q1 of 2024, with construction anticipated to begin in Q2.

Phase two of the project, which includes the remainder of Jane Street, from Major Mackenzie Drive to Teston Road, is scheduled for 2025.



What are in-boulevard cycle tracks?

In-boulevard cycle tracks are designated spaces for people riding bikes separated from those walking or driving. These areas are marked with a bicycle symbol, arrow and diamond.
