The Drinking Water Quality Management System was re-accredited by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks in 2021. The City's Water Distribution System remains fully accredited following two external surveillance audits of the City's Operational Plan on May 19, 2022 and June 28, 2023.

The City operates and maintains:

- **1,150 km** of watermains
- **10,500** fire hydrants
- **53,500** water valves
- **1** booster station
- **1** pressure elevating station



DID YOU KNOW, Vaughan's water comes from Lake Ontario and is treated by the City of Toronto and the Region of Peel? Then, the water is provided to York Region, which supplies it to the City of Vaughan for distribution.

In 2023, **\$18.5 million** was invested to install, repair and/or replace infrastructure required to deliver safe drinking water.

In 2023, nearly **36 million cubic metres** of water was supplied to residential, industrial, commercial and institutional locations throughout Vaughan.
