

Road Resurfacing and Rehabilitation

Dear resident,

The City of Vaughan will be restoring community roads and making required repairs to existing curbs and sidewalks to the following roads in the Ward 1 community:

- Bute Court
- Cedar Glen Court
- Forest Heights Boulevard
- Huntington Road
- Kipling Avenue (Kleinburg)

- Kirby Road
- Old Humber Crescent
- Pentland Crescent
- Shalimar Place

The contract has been awarded to Viola Management Inc. Construction is expected to begin in early May and is anticipated to be complete by November 2024.

Here are the answers to your most frequently asked questions:

The contractor installed new sod on my lawn. Who is responsible for the maintenance?

The contractor is responsible for watering and maintaining the new sod. However, you are encouraged to water it as frequently as possible to ensure root growth and healthy green grass.

My driveway is blocked due to the work. Will I get a parking ticket if I park on the roadway?


The City's By-law department has been notified of the roadways impacted by construction and staff was instructed not to issue tickets. However, if you are parked contrary to the posted parking prohibitions, or parked within nine metres of any intersection, three metres of a fire hydrant or less than a metre away from any private driveway, you could be ticketed.
