



To book an appliance pickup, purchase City garbage tags or bins, or request a City bin exchange, visit vaughan.ca/ServiceVaughan



Organics

Line your green bin or kitchen container with a compostable or plastic bag and tie securely.

Tissues, paper towels and napkins **go in the green bin**, not the blue box.



Recycling

All items must be loose, empty and rinsed. **Bagged recyclables are not accepted**. **Reduce wind-blown litter** by leaving space at the top of the blue box,

Leaf and Yard Waste

Materials must be bundled, bagged or placed in waste containers (without lids) marked "Yard Waste."

Bundles can be up to 1.5 metres (five feet) in length and 0.6 metres (two feet) in diameter.

Individual branches can be up to 10 centimetres (four inches) in diameter.



Delay seasonal yard work until late spring to protect Vaughan's pollinators!



Garbage

Limit of three items

Use garbage tags for more than three and up to 13 items.



flattening cardboard and placing heavy recyclable items on top.

Large or bulky items

Each item counts toward the three-item limit.

Broken glass and other sharp objects must be placed
in a box, closed securely and labelled.



Waste Depot Information

Batteries, cleaners, construction materials, electronics, fluorescent light bulbs and paint are not collected curbside.

Choose the Right Bins

Use blue boxes for recycling and black/grey bins and bags for garbage.

Weight and size limits

- All bags and bins must weigh less than 20.5 kilograms (45 pounds).
- Blue boxes and garbage bins must be less than 121 litres (32 gallons), with no attached lid

 Place waste curbside by 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Collection times may change without notice.
 Crews will not return for materials set out late. Missed your collection?


- Give your gently used household goods a new home with Curbside Giveaway Days, on from May to October.






Double-Up Days: dispose of up to six garbage items
