BY-LAW NUMBER 068-2025

A By-law to amend City of Vaughan By-law 001-2021, as amended.

WHEREAS the matters herein set out are in conformity with the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area, which is approved and in force at this time;

AND WHEREAS there has been no amendment to the Vaughan Official Plan adopted by Council but not approved at this time, with which the matters herein set out are not in conformity;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That City of Vaughan By-law Number 001-2021, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended by:
 - a) Deleting Subsection 6.5.1.3 and replacing it with the word “Deleted”.
 - b) Deleting Subsection 6.5.1.4 and replacing it with the following:

“4. The minimum width of an aisle providing access to a bicycle parking space located within a building shall be 1.75 m.”

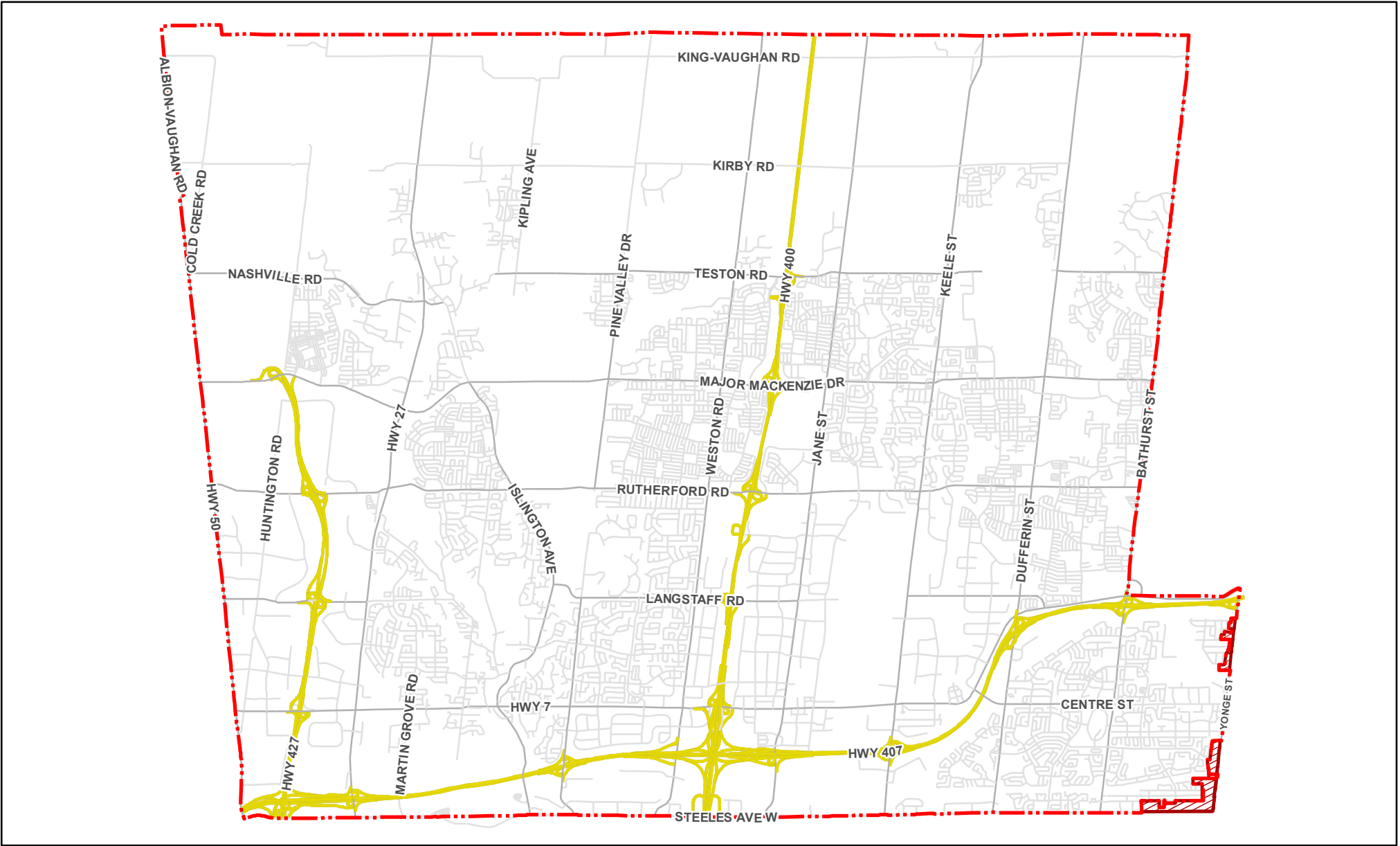

SUMMARY TO BY-LAW 068-2025

The lands subject to this By-law include all lands within the City of Vaughan where By-law 001-2021 is applicable.

The purpose of this By-law is to amend City of Vaughan Zoning By-law 001-2021 to remove Subsection 6.5.1.3 from the By-law as it conflicts with Subsection 6.5.4.3 and amend Subsection 6.5.1.4 to clarify the requirement of the minimum aisle width for a bicycle parking space located within a building.
