

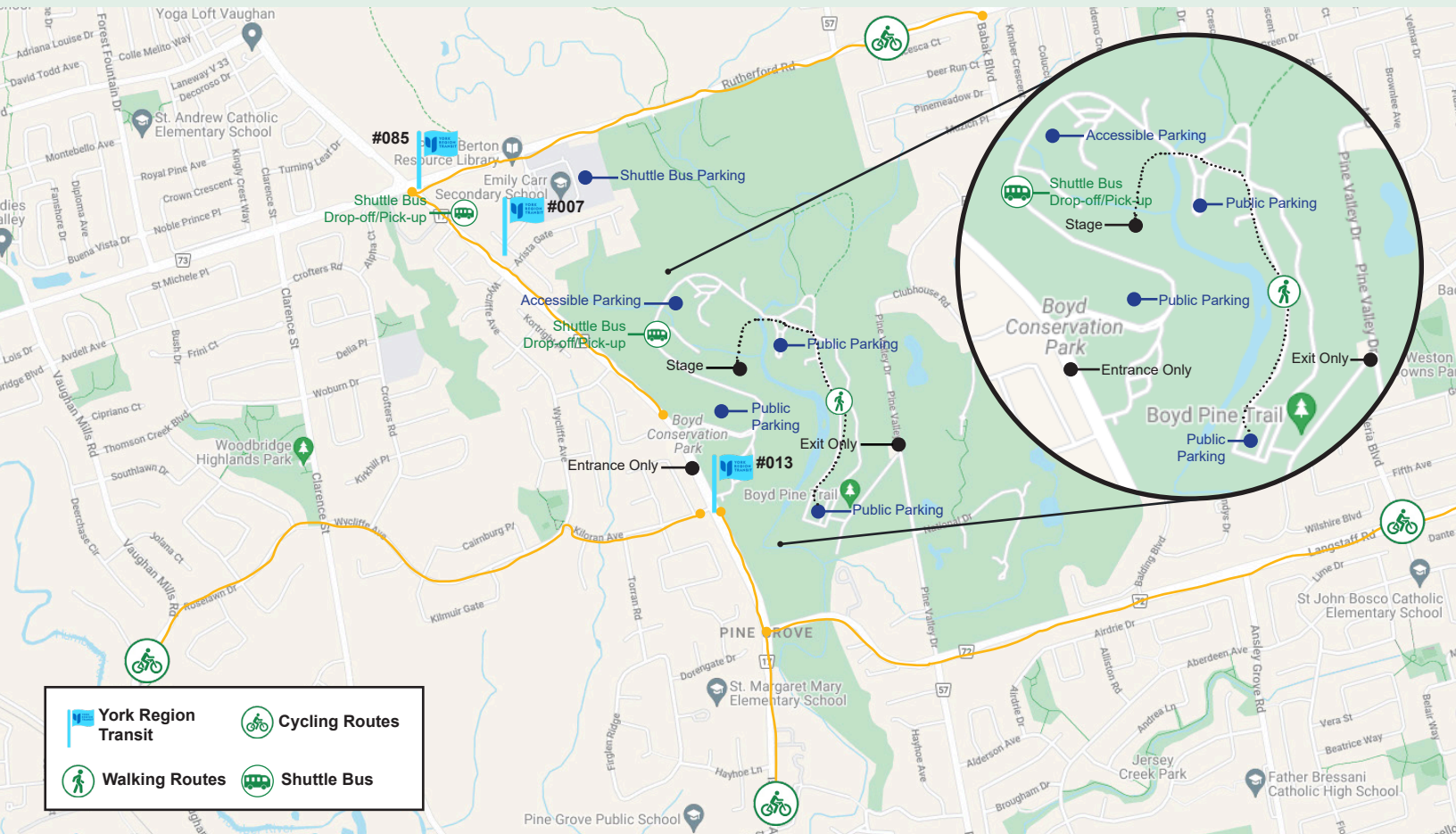

OPTION 1: PUBLIC TRANSIT

- Boyd Conservation Park is conveniently accessible via several York Region Transit buses, such as: #007, #013, and #085.
- Check the map to see which bus stop works best for your commute.



OPTION 2: WALKING (& PARKING)

- To enjoy a stroll and get some exercise, explore the optimal walking route.
- Limited free parking is available at Boyd Conservation Park and is a short walk to the site.
- Overflow parking spots are also available at Al Palladini Community Centre, Chancellor Community Centre, Emily Carr Secondary School, Father E. Bulfon Community Centre, Vaughan City Hall, Vaughan Metropolitan Area (paid parking), Woodbridge Pool & Memorial Arena, and Woodbridge Public School.
- Driving to public parking at the site is one-way where traffic is from Islington to exit on Pine Valley.



OPTION 3: SHUTTLE BUSES

Free parking and shuttle bus services available at the following locations:

- Al Palladini Community Centre - 9201 Islington Ave.
- Chancellor Community Centre - 350 Ansley Grove Rd.
- Father E. Bulfon Community Centre - 8141 Martin Grove Rd.
- Vaughan City Hall - 2141 Major MacKenzie Dr West
- VMC Library - 200 Apple Mill Rd.
- Woodbridge Library - 150 Woodbridge Ave.

Service begins at 10:00 AM at all locations. Last pickup at Boyd Park is at 8:30 PM.
