BY-LAW NUMBER 146-2025

A By-law to amend Delegation By-law 144-2018 as amended, to delegate authority to approve and execute pre-servicing and servicing agreements to facilitate the construction of critical municipal infrastructure projects to service planned housing and employment land development projects during Council Hiatus.

WHEREAS section 23.1, and 23.2(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 (the "Municipal Act"), authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws respecting the economic, social, and environmental well-being of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the City of Vaughan has recognized the need to delegate authority to staff and has enacted Delegation By-law 144-2018;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan considers it desirable to amend the Delegation By-law, as amended, to delegate authority to the Deputy City Manager, Infrastructure Development, or their designate, to approve and execute pre-servicing and servicing agreements and any amendments thereto required to facilitate the construction of critical municipal infrastructure projects necessary to service planned housing and employment land development projects during Council Hiatus.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT Schedule "A" of By-law 144-2018, as amended, be hereby further amended
to add the delegation of powers and duties under the heading "Land Development
Agreements" as set out in Schedule "A" hereto.
