Tennis court redevelopment: York Hill District Park

Improvements are coming to York Hill District Park, located adjacent to Garnet A. Williams Community Centre, at 330 York Hill Blvd.

Improvements will include:

- replacing the decommissioned triple-court tennis area with one dedicated tennis court and four dedicated pickleball courts, including adding new surfacing, fencing and lighting.
- renewing the active triple-court tennis area, including adding new surfacing, fencing and lighting.
- replacing and realigning park pathways adjacent to the tennis court areas.
- constructing new seating areas and a central gathering space with new shade tables and plantings.
- removing the existing tennis rebound wall and replacing it with a large picnic pavilion.
- replacing the small shade structure with a large picnic pavilion.

Work is underway and will be completed in December 2026 according to the following schedule:

- **June 2025 to December 2026:** Work to replace the decommissioned triple-court tennis area with one dedicated tennis court and four dedicated pickleball courts.
- **September 2025 to June 2026:** Work to renew the tennis court area, including adding new surfacing, fencing and lighting, and removing the existing tennis rebound wall and replacing it with a large picnic pavilion.

To safely complete the work, the following areas will be closed during construction:

- tennis court areas
- pathways adjacent to each tennis court area
- basketball court
- small swing area
- tennis rebound wall

Installation of a new lighting system for the tennis courts may temporarily affect nighttime lighting until the fall.


Signs and barriers will be in place to guide park users during construction. Intermittent closures of the main park pathway may occur during the delivery and removal of material and/or products to the construction zone. Access to the community centre will not be impacted and all other park amenities will remain open.
