Context

To engage youth on the Greenspace Strategic Plan, high school students were identified as a key demographic to gather feedback from, as older youth and teens are traditionally underrepresented in planning and engagement projects.

A design activity prompted students to create a poster that would encourage youth to visit their favourite park or greenspace. Students were encouraged to create a slogan and highlight key features that would attract other youth to visit the greenspace they selected.

In addition, students provided valuable insights through a workbook activity, which focused on the importance of greenspaces, and explored barriers and opportunities from their perspective.

This lookbook showcases the incredible park poster designs received by the City of Vaughan during Phase 2 of the Greenspace Strategic Plan project. Insightful quotes from the workbook activity are included throughout.



HISTORY

Frederick Law Olmsted came up with the idea for Central Park to have woodlands with lots of paths and picturesque landscapes so everyone could experience a rural landscape. Construction began in 1858 with workers planting 500,000 trees, shrubs, and vines. In the following years the park underwent many changes with many ups and downs; including the construction of the mall, great lawn, playground and many more. It now serves as a beautiful greenspace, a place for people to escape from the busy industrialized New York.

Park Güell

A PARK FOR EVERYONE

Park Güell, designed by the masterful architect, Antoni Gaudí, and commissioned by Eusebi Güell, is a UNESCO world heritage recognized park in Barcelona, Spain. Located on the hillside of the city, the park initially started construction between 1900-1914 and was built in the idea of a residential park intended for sixty single-family residences. The project, however, was unsuccessful, and the park became city property in 1923. Only three of the commissioned villas were built in the end, one being used as an elementary school, another one being used as the Gaudí Museum, and the last one, which is named the Casa Trias, is being used for what it was actually intended, an old family. When Güell first commissioned the idea to Gaudí, he strictly stated that he wanted Gaudí, as the architect and engineer, to let his ideas and imagination go free. The result was around 45 acres of pure beauty from the mind of Antoni Gaudí himself. The park contains the iconic lizard fountain that is seen in all tourist advertisements, a court with a view overlooking the entire city of Barcelona in its beauty, many other sculptures made out of warped stone and marble covered in colourful mosaic tile, and a green space aspect of colourful flora. It is truly a park for everyone.
