Nashville Park 639 Barons Street

Nashville Park is a relatively square 1.4 ha neighborhood **train station themed** park bound by Port Renfrew Avenue (South), Barons Street (West), Nashville Road (North), and the rear lots of Stilton Avenue residences (East). The park will include the following amenities: linear park pathway lighting, shade structure, site furnishings, junior/senior playgrounds, unlit double tennis court with pickleball line overlay, multi-use lawn, native meadow and tree plantings forming an urban canopy walk.
