UPDATE: Pedestrian trail closures in Rainbow Creek Park until Friday Aug. 29

The next phase of work in Rainbow Creek Park, located at 5450 Highway 7, includes re-paving the existing asphalt pathways in the eastern section of the park.

To safely complete the work, the following pedestrian trails will be **closed to the public until Friday, Aug. 29**:

- Segments of trails north of Highway 7 and south of Houston Road and Moonstone Place
- Segments of trails west of Rainbow Drive and Villagewood Court

Pathway closure and detour signs will be in place to direct pedestrians.

What you need to know:

- Construction fencing will be in place within the park and at park entrances located at Rainbow Drive, Villagewood Court, Moonstone Place and Houston Road.
- The Rainbow Creek Park parking lot and soccer field will remain open.
- All adjacent roads will remain open.

About the project:

The City of Vaughan is upgrading Rainbow Creek Park.

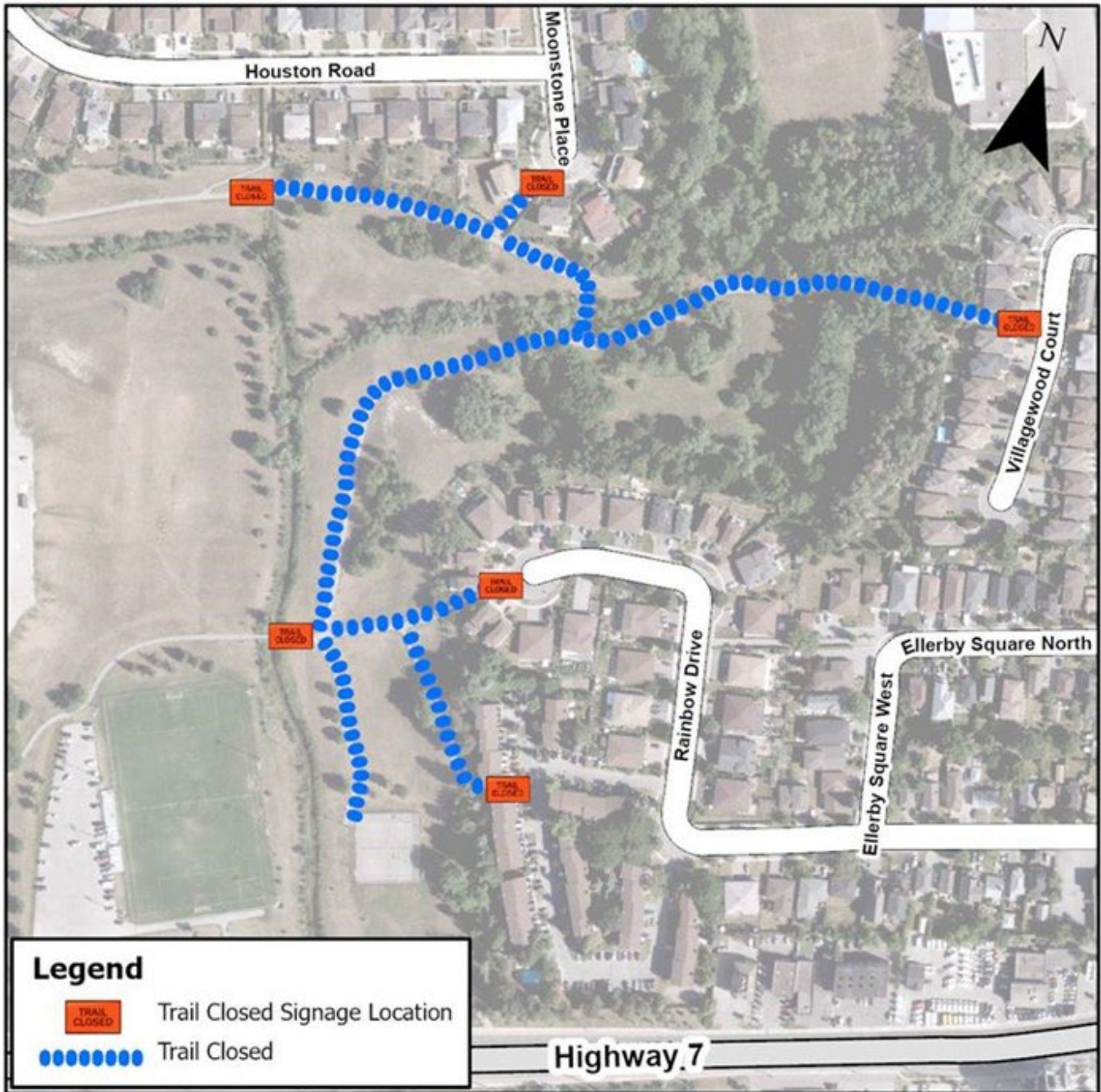
Work includes the construction of two stormwater management ponds, the installation of a new tennis court, reconstructing pathways and relocating pedestrian lighting.
