


Survey was live from March 19 to April 19, 2025

Participants were reached through a project notice to **1,998** community members, project webpage, roadside signs, community centre TVs, a public service announcement, eNewsletters and social media.

WHAT WE HEARD

Participants' dog ownership





Participants were asked to provide their thoughts on a proposed fenced-in, off-leash dog park located at Pierre Elliott Trudeau (PET) Park. **Responses were mixed, with slightly more opposed to the off-leash area than supportive**. Much of the opposition came from those located closest to PET Park, while support came from the broader Thornhill community.

Common themes from the comments received included:

- SUPPORT FOR THE OFF-LEASH DOG AREA –
 many participants expressed their support
 for the proposed off-leash area and their
 excitement for a new place to take their pets.
 These participants were supportive of the
 location and noted the need for more
 off-leash dog areas in the neighbourhood.
- COMMUNITY SAFETY CONCERNS many participants were concerned about community safety, noting the potential for negative interactions between dogs, older adults, youth and young children due to the nearby high school and library.
- COYOTE CONCERNS many noted there have been coyotes sighted in the area and had concerns about the safety of their pets using this park.

- STUDENT SAFETY CONCERNS many participants, including school staff and parents/guardians, expressed concerns about student safety and the potential for negative interactions with dogs, noting that students from the local high school frequently walk through this park to reach the mall.
- NOISE CONCERNS some had concerns about noise from the dog park, particularly for residents who live nearby.
- DESIRE FOR MORE SHADE of those who were supportive, some suggested adding shade for dog owners supervising their dog(s).
- REQUEST FOR A WATER FOUNTAIN FOR DOGS – some participants also suggested including a water fountain for dogs in the off-leash area design.
