# ***BY-LAW***

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 217-2025**

**A By-law to Stop and Close a portion of Hunter's Valley Road as a public highway and lift 0.3m Reserve(s) in the City of Vaughan.**

**WHEREAS** at its meeting of September 22, 2025, Council approved staff recommendation to lift reserves, lands to be deemed surplus subject to a permanent municipal servicing and access easement and stopped up and closed portions of Hunter's Valley Road;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of intention of the City of Vaughan to pass this by-law was published on the City's website on August 22, 2025;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the lands which are situated in the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, being a portion of Hunter's Valley Road, legally described as Part of Hunter's Valley Road, Plan 65M-4318, designated as Parts 36 to 39 inclusive on Reference Plan 65R-40994 be and is hereby stopped up and closed as public highway in accordance with section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
2. THAT the lands which are situated in the City of Vaughan, in the Regional Municipality of York, dedicated as 0.3m Reserves, legally described as All of Block 24 (0.3m Reserve), Plan 65M 4318, designated as Parts 30, 31 & 32 on Reference Plan 65R-40994 be and are hereby having the dedication as 0.3m Reserve lifted.
