

Disruption Alert

NOTICE: Road closure on Nashville Road, from Highway 27 to Islington Avenue

The next phase of work in Kleinburg Village includes asphalt paving on Nashville Road. To safely complete the work, a full road closure is required on Nashville Road, from Highway 27 to Islington Avenue on the following dates:

- **Monday, Sept. 22 to Wednesday, Sept. 24, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.**
- **Monday, Sept. 29, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

Nashville Road will be open to local traffic only during construction and driveways will remain accessible. Traffic control and detour signs will be in place.

What you need to know:

- Northbound traffic on Islington Avenue, approaching Nashville Road, will be re-directed north to Highway 27.
- Eastbound traffic on Nashville Road will be re-directed north on Highway 27 towards Islington Avenue.
- Northbound traffic on Highway 27, approaching Nashville Road will be directed north towards Islington Avenue.
- Southbound traffic on Highway 27, approaching Nashville Road will be re-directed towards Islington Avenue.
- All businesses along Islington Avenue and Nashville Road in Kleinburg Village will remain open during the work.

About the project:

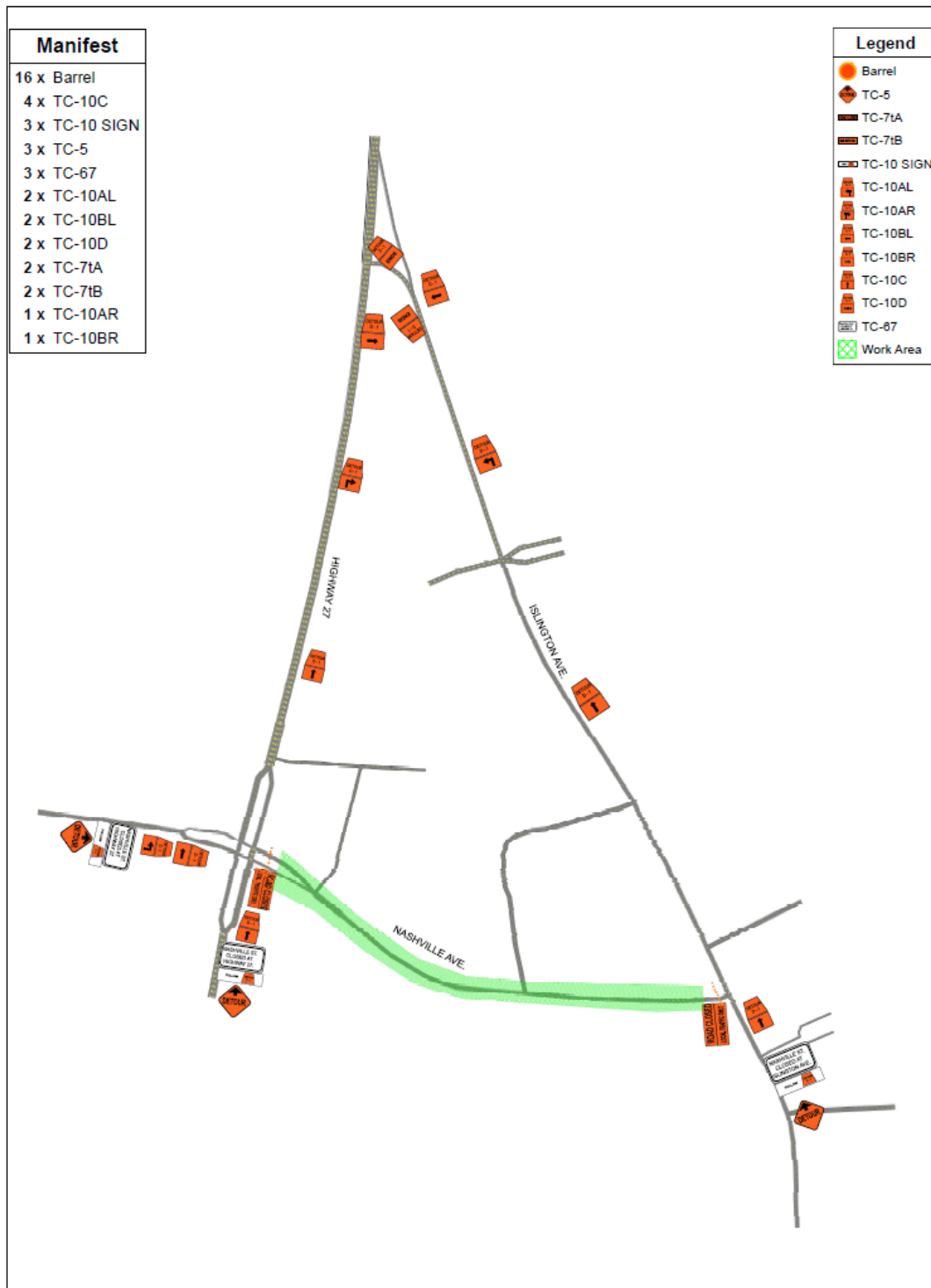
