## NOTICE: Improvements are coming to Sugarbush Heritage Park!

The City of Vaughan is making improvements to Sugarbush Heritage Park (91 Thornhill Woods Dr.), including:

- a renewed community garden.
- new pathway lighting and seating.
- new playground equipment, including a play pit with engineered wood fibre surfacing.
- pedestrian pathway upgrades around the playground.

Work is scheduled to begin on **Monday, Oct. 6 and be completed by the end of November 2025**, pending site and weather conditions.

To safely complete the work, the following areas will be closed to the public during construction:

- the playground
- the community garden
- part of the east parking lot
- segments of pedestrian pathways closest to the playground and community garden

The off-leash dog area, public washroom, Baker House and Baker Sugarbush Woodlot Trail will remain open and accessible during construction. Signs and barriers will be in place to guide visitors.
