UPATE: Improvements to Sugarbush Heritage Park continue into 2026

The City of Vaughan is making improvements to Sugarbush Heritage Park (91 Thornhill Woods Dr.), including:

- a renewed community garden.
- new pathway lighting and seating.
- new playground equipment, including a play pit with engineered wood fibre surfacing.
- pedestrian pathway upgrades around the playground.

The work, which commenced in October 2025, is ongoing and anticipated to be completed in late spring/early summer 2026.

The following areas will be closed to the public during construction:

- the playground
- the community garden
- part of the east parking lot
- segments of pedestrian pathways closest to the playground and community garden

The off-leash dog area, public washroom, Baker House and Baker Sugarbush Woodlot Trail will remain open and accessible during construction. Signs and barriers are in place to guide visitors and temporary power and lighting have been installed in the park during construction.
