BY-LAW NUMBER 048-2026

A By-law to amend the Administrative Penalties By-law 240-2024, as amended, to include the Discharge and Display of Firearms By-law, By-law 123-2016, as amended, as a designated by-law.

WHEREAS section 434.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (“*Municipal Act*”) provides that a municipality may require a person to pay an administrative monetary penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a by-law of the municipality passed under the *Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the City of Vaughan has enacted the *Administrative Penalties By-law* which lists all by-laws for which administrative penalties may be issued;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Vaughan considers it desirable to amend the *Administrative Penalties By-law* to add the *Discharge and Display of Firearms By-law* as a by-law under which administrative penalties may be issued.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. To amend the Administrative Penalties By-law 240-2024, as amended, by making the following addition to Schedule 1:
