

Disruption Alert

Notice: Noise barrier installation in Max Eisen Memorial Park

The City of Vaughan is installing noise barriers around the pickleball courts in Max Eisen Memorial Park (330 York Hill Blvd.). To minimize disruptions, the work will take place in phases.

Phase 1 (Monday, July 27 to Saturday, Aug. 8): Preliminary construction work, including strengthening the existing fence posts, will take place overnight. To accommodate this work, the pickleball courts will close daily at 7 p.m. and reopen the following morning at 7 a.m. The courts will remain open during the day.

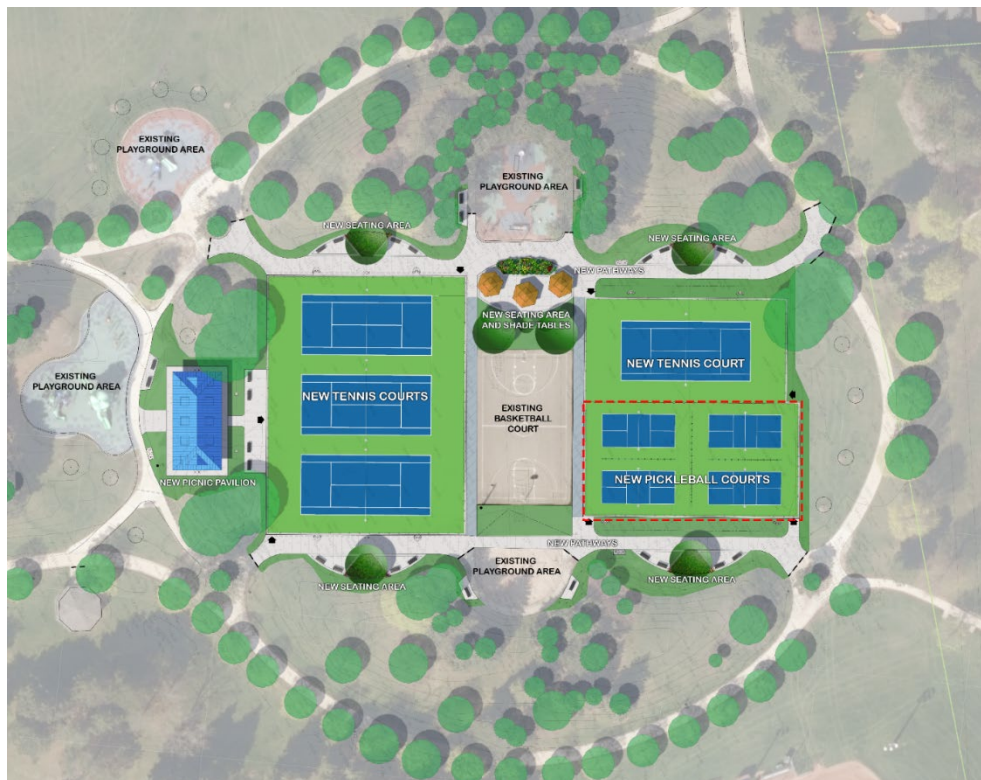
Phase 2 (October 2026): Installation of the noise barriers will take place in October and is expected to be completed within two weeks.

About the project

The City of Vaughan is making improvements in Max Eisen Memorial Park. Completed work includes upgraded tennis courts, four new dedicated pickleball courts and a new picnic pavilion. Work will continue through the summer, including site cleanup, paving, installation of sound barriers around the pickleball courts, pathway repairs and planting. Some areas will be temporarily closed while construction is underway.
