UPDATE: Islington Avenue roadwork impacted by severe weather

The Sept. 2 storm that caused widespread flooding across Vaughan significantly impacted construction activities and roadway conditions along Islington Avenue in Kleinburg Village. As a result, additional roadway repairs are necessary to ensure the long-term sustainability and safety of the road.

To safely and efficiently complete the repairs, Islington Avenue will be fully closed between Nashville Road and Treelawn Boulevard, from Monday, Oct. 5 until Friday, Oct. 9. Businesses will remain open and accessible during this time.

More about the road closure:

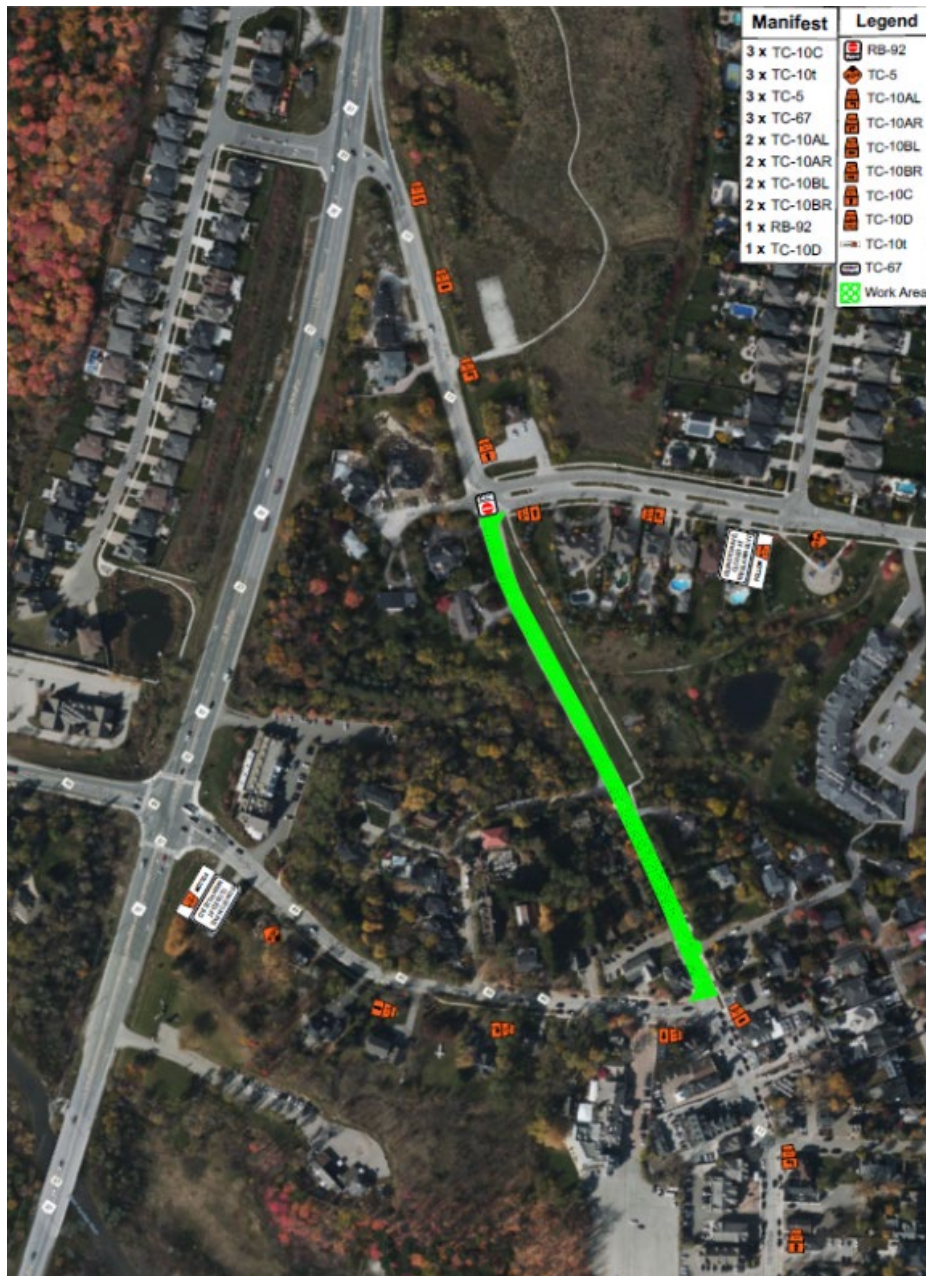
- Access will be maintained for local residents, businesses and emergency services.
- Northbound traffic on Islington Avenue will be redirected west on Nashville Road towards Highway 27.
- Lester B. Pearson Street will remain closed at Islington Avenue. Eastbound traffic will be redirected west towards Nashville Road.
- Westbound traffic from Treelawn Boulevard will be redirected north on Islington Avenue towards Highway 27.

About the project:

The City is undertaking important infrastructure improvements within Kleinburg Village, including watermain replacements, road reconstruction work and streetscaping enhancements.
