NOTICE: Improvements are coming to Vaughan Sports Village Park!

The City of Vaughan is making improvements in Vaughan Sports Village Park (2600 Rutherford Rd.), that will provide new recreational opportunities and enhance accessibility, safety and connectivity within the park.

Improvements will take place according to the following schedule:

- **Bocce court upgrades (September 2026 to the end of October 2026):** work will include replacing the wood edging and rubber surfacing and installing LED court lighting.
- **Pathway upgrades (September 2026 to the end of November 2026):** the pathway to the junior baseball diamond will be replaced with concrete and extended to the pathway loop.
- **New playground construction (September 2026 to July 2027):** work will include construction of a new playground with a shade structure, pathway, lighting, landscaping and accessibility improvements.

To safely complete the work the following areas will be temporarily closed during construction:

- select pathways and park areas
- the bocce courts
- the parking lot south of the bocce courts
- a portion of the parking lot off Melville Avenue

Signs and barriers will be in place to guide park visitors.
