BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 208-2011

A By-law to further amend Parking By-law 1-96, as amended.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan has determined that it is desirable to make further amendments to the Parking By-law 1-96, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 10.1(5)(iii) of Parking By-law 1-96, as amended, (the "Parking By-law") is hereby amended by deleting the word "or".
2. Section 10.1(5)(iv) of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by replacing the term "practicable." with the phrase "practicable; or"
3. Section 10.1(5) of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

"v) sending it by regular mail to the motor vehicle owner's last known address, which shall be deemed to be effective on the seventh day after it is mailed."
4. Section 10.1 of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

"(26) Where an administrative penalty is affirmed pursuant to subsection 8, the Director of Enforcement Services may cancel or reduce the penalty, or extend the time to request a review of the administrative penalty where the person establishes, beyond a reasonable doubt, that they did not receive the penalty notice".
