Background – Analysis and Options

The subject lands shown on Attachment #1 are located on the west side of Regional Road #27, south of Kirby Road, City of Vaughan.

The applicant has submitted street names for three streets in approved Plan of Subdivision File 19T-08V06 (1422174 Ontario Ltd.), as shown on Attachment #2 for approval. The Transportation and Community Planning Department for the Region of York has no objection to the proposed names.

The Vaughan Fire and Rescue Department and Vaughan Development Planning Department have also reviewed the proposed street names, which are considered to be satisfactory.

The street names are consistent with the City's Street Naming Policy and Procedures that was approved by Vaughan Council on June 26, 2012.
