REQUEST OF REPORT FOR TRAFFIC REVIEW OF MELVILLE AVE.

The Committee of the Whole recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following resolution submitted by Councillor Iafrate, dated May 21, 2013:

Whereas, Melville Avenue, from Rutherford Road to Major Mackenzie Drive, is a four lane collector road conveying high volumes of traffic within Ward 1; and

Whereas, a community safety zone was established in 2011, from the north limit of West Maple Creek Park to Springside Drive on Melville Avenue, to increase driver awareness of community activity within the designated area; and

Whereas, various concerns continue to be raised by residents within this community about traffic activity on Melville Avenue;

It is therefore recommended that staff bring forward a report reviewing traffic operations on Melville Avenue, from Rutherford Road to Major Mackenzie Drive, for the June 18th meeting of the Committee of the Whole.
