Purpose

To respond to the request received from the President of *L'Association de francophones de la région de York (L'AFRY),* received May 10, 2013 (Attachment 1).

Background - Analysis and Options

A request has been received from *L'Association de francophones de la région de York* (L'AFRY) to proclaim September 25, 2013 as "Franco-Ontarian Day" and to raise the Franco-Ontarian flag at Vaughan City Hall. This is a very important and historical celebration for all Franco-Ontarians in Ontario and in our community. The proclamation and flag raising would raise awareness and officially recognize the contributions made by Franco-Ontarians to the cultural, historical, social and economic life of our community. Council has previously granted this request.

The flag raising request meets the City's Flag Raising/Half-Masting Policy, as follows:

"In recognition of the ethnic diversity of the residents of the municipality the City of Vaughan will fly at the Vaughan City Hall the flag of any nation, country or ethnic group on the national day or on the anniversary of a special occasion, upon a written request to the City Clerk submitted one month in advance by that nation, or ethnic group or its representatives".
