- 2) Assess what measures are being taken to ensure compliance with existing by-laws;
- 3) Pursuant to the City of Vaughan By-law Strategy, undertake a review of the applicable City and Regional Sign by-laws, in consultation with the appropriate Regional staff; and
- 4) Bring a report back to a future Committee of the Whole.
