**PROCLAMATION REQUEST
LUNG MONTH**

The Committee of the Whole recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following report of the City Clerk, dated November 1, 2016:

Recommendation

The City Clerk recommends:

1. That November 2016 be proclaimed as “Lung Month”; and
2. That the proclamation be posted on the City’s website and published on the City Page online.

The Corporate Communications Department posts proclamations issued by the City on the City’s website under “Council – Proclamations” and on the City Page Online.

Purpose

To respond to the request received from the President and CEO of the Lung Association of Ontario.

Background - Analysis and Options

Correspondence was received from the President and CEO of the Lung Association in the Office of the Mayor and forwarded to the Office of the City Clerk.

The proclamation request meets the requirements of the City’s Proclamation Policy, as follows:

“That upon request, the City of Vaughan issue Proclamations for events, campaigns or other similar matters:

- (i) which are promoted by any organization that is a registered charity pursuant to Section 248 of the Income Tax Act”.

More than 2.4 million people in Ontario (or 1 in 5 people) experience serious breathing challenges such as asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and lung cancer. Lung disease remains the only one of the top four chronic diseases in Ontario without a comprehensive plan. This proclamation request would help support outreach initiatives to inform and educate all Ontarians about how to protect their breathing and to advocate for a comprehensive Ontario Lung Health Action Plan.
