The proclamation request meets one of the requirements of the City’s Proclamation Policy, namely:

“If the event, campaign, or declaration is directly related to matters over which the City has jurisdiction or the City sponsors the event, campaign, or other matter”.

This is the 35th year of the Sarah and Chaim Neuberger Holocaust Education Centre’s Holocaust Education Week program. The request for proclamation is made in order for the program to receive civic endorsement from the City of Vaughan, as well as raise continued awareness about the Holocaust.
