**CIVIC HERO AWARD NOMINEE, WARD 2, 2016**

**The Committee of the Whole (Closed Session) recommends approval of the recommendation contained in the following resolution of Councillor Carella, dated December 5, 2016:**

**Recommendation**

Submitted by Councillor Tony Carella:

Whereas, Fred Santini is a long-time resident of Ward 2 in the City of Vaughan, and

Whereas, he was a leading force in the creation and development of Shining Through, a centre for children with autism, founded and based in the City of Vaughan and now operating branches in other municipalities; and

Whereas, he remains a committed volunteer working in service to Shining Through and its clients; and

Whereas, his commitment and that of the other members of Shining Through's staff and volunteers demonstrates the qualities that constitute civic leadership, and indeed civic heroism.

It Is therefore recommended:

1. That Fred Santini be awarded the 2016 Civic Hero Award for Ward 2; and
2. That the award be presented at an evening meeting of the Committee of the Whole (Public Hearing), in early 2017.
