THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF VAUGHAN

BY-LAW NUMBER 44-86

A By-law to provide for the numbering of buildings in the Town of Vaughan.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Vaughan considers it necessary to number buildings along the public highways in the Town of Vaughan and desires to enact a by-law pursuant to the provisions of Section 210, Paragraph 106 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, C.302;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the numbers of the buildings on each public highway as set out from time to time in the record of municipal numbers in the Planning Department of the Town of Vaughan shall be the official numbers for all such buildings in the Town.

2. THAT the owner of a building shall affix or cause to be affixed the official number for that building to a wall of that building facing a public highway, or to another location such as a mailbox or signpost for that building so as to be clearly visible from the highway.

3. AND THAT no person shall affix to any building or permit to be affixed to any building or other location, any number except that appearing in said record as the number of such building.

4. AND THAT every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, is liable to a fine not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) exclusive of costs, for each offence.
