Whereas, she has acted in a trusted stewardship role in the community for Kleinburg United Church and Bindertwine; and

*Whereas,* she continues to keep an independent record of Kleinburg's diverse and colourful history and supports all local groups by providing 'snippets from our past' to all who will listen; and

Whereas, she is a pioneer and strong advocate for re-cycling and re-use activities within the community; and
