BY-LAW

BY-LAW NUMBER 520-2001

A By-law to amend By-law 1-96 as amended, to govern and control parking of motor vehicles in the City of Vaughan.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS as FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the City of Vaughan By-law 1-96 as amended, be and it is hereby further amended by deleting Section 13 (1) and replacing it with the following:

“In addition to any other penalties provided for in this By-law, a member of the York Regional Police Force, Ontario Provincial Police Force, a Provincial Offences Officer or a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer may move or cause to be moved a vehicle, or seize, detain or impound a vehicle or cause a vehicle to be seized, detained or impounded and taken to and stored in a safe and otherwise suitable place under any one of the following circumstances:

- (a) the vehicle is in contravention of Sections 6 or 7 of this By-law.
- (b) the vehicle is unlawfully occupying any portion of a highway or municipal property.
- (c) The vehicle is parked on any highway or municipal property in such a manner as to impede the removal of snow by the City, its contractors or authorized agents engaged in work upon a highway.”

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed this 18th day of December, 2001.
