5 NON-UNION EMPLOYEES & ELECTED OFFICIALS ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT

The Committee of the Whole (Closed Session) recommends:

- 1) That the following recommendation contained in the report of the Interim City Manager, the Commissioner of Strategic and Corporate Services and the Director of Human Resources, dated November 26, 2013, be approved:
 - 1. That the Non-Union Employee Salary Schedules be amended to implement economic adjustments which reflect the adjustments negotiated with CUPE for 2013, 2014 and 2015;
 - 2. That in accordance with the Grant Thornton recommendations adopted by Council in 2002, Elected Officials' Salary Schedules be amended to implement economic adjustments consistent with non-union salary schedules for 2013, 2014 and 2015;
 - 3. That the attached Appendices 1 through VI reflecting the effective dates be approved;
 - 4. That the economic adjustments be made, effective January 1, 2013, for all affected Employees/Elected Officials in the employ of the City of Vaughan as at December 1, 2013;
 - 5. That By-law 100-2002 be amended to include the revised Appendices 1 through VI;
 - 6. That By-law 316-2007 be amended as attached; and
 - 7. That staff undertake a comprehensive review of the City's pay line policy for nonunion employees along with the Management By-law and provide recommendations to Council for consideration by the end of 2014; and
- 2) That the Management By-law be amended to incorporate Members of Council into the non-union category.
