THE CITY OF VAUGHAN **BY-LAW**

BY-LAW NUMBER 82-2012

A By-law to further amend Parking By-law 1-96, as amended.

WHEREAS paragraph 1 of section 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that lower-tier municipalities may pass by-laws relating to highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 8 of section 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that lower-tier municipalities may pass by-laws relating to parking, except on highways;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Vaughan deems it advisable to pass further amendments to Parking By-law 1-96, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Vaughan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 2(1)(o) of Parking By-law 1-96, as amended, (hereinafter the "Parking By-law") is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "of not more than 30 metres".
- 2. Section 4 of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:
 - (6.1) No person shall park or stop a vehicle on or over a sidewalk.
- 3. Section 4(6)(a) of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by deleting "sidewalk,".
- 4. Section 4 of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:
 - (11) No person shall park a commercial vehicle on a residential lot.
- 5. Section 13(1) of the Parking By-law is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "of sections 6 and 7".
