This year marks our 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and the Kleinburg Nobleton Soccer Club continues to experience continued growth and soccer development in our communities. Our foundation began with the vision to nurture this wonderful sport and develop the young people in our community. The Club encountered a number of challenges and the difficulties before establishing itself as a full member of the York Region Soccer Association and as a community service organization with the City of Vaughan. The Club originally consisted of a total of five rep teams with only one main field at their disposal. Today the KNSC consists of approximately 1500 players in both the Rep and House league programs. The Club has increased and is continuing to increase steadily as is evident of all the new home developments which are planned within our boundaries. In order to meet this growth the Club requires more fields in order to provide soccer programs for all its members.

Today we have approximately 12 fields, including a turf field at Sonoma Heights. With increasing registrations, the KNSC requires more fields. We are continuously working with the City of Vaughan in trying to get more fields. Soccer has become a 12 month sport and indoor facilities are becoming less available as we go on and especially in order to meet the Ontario Soccer Associations Long Term Player Development requirements. Upon review of the proposed Recreational Complex which includes indoor and outdoor fields, it should also include the potential for a turf field with a winter bubble, the KNSC is in full support of the proposal and we believe that it is adequate and appropriate to meet our needs. We will continue to work closely with the owner to provide information regarding field requirements and specifications. The location of the proposed Recreational Complex would serve existing Kleinburg and future urban area development well.

In closing, the requirement of additional soccer fields is evident with the KNSC and the proposed Recreational Complex of this type and size would be extremely beneficial to us. We full support this application and are looking forward for this concept to become reality!
