Recommendation

The Commissioner of Community Services, in consultation with the Acting Director of Purchasing Services and the Director of Parks & Forestry Operations, recommends:

- 1. That Tender T12-369 for the Snow Plowing and Salting of City of Vaughan Facilities be awarded to Forest Contractors Ltd. for Areas A & B for two (2) years at a total cost of \$663,705.50 (including HST) with an option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year terms, at the discretion of the City; and,
- 2. That a contingency allowance in the amount of \$99,555.00 (15%) be approved within which the Director of Parks and Forestry Operations is authorized to approve amendments to the contract; and,
- That a bylaw be enacted authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the necessary documents.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to award Tender T12-369 for the Snow Plowing and Salting of City of Vaughan Facilities.

Background - Analysis and Options

The City of Vaughan is responsible for snow plowing and salting of City of Vaughan facility parking lots, walkways, firehalls and EMS stations located throughout the City.

A tender was issued to include labour, equipment and salt to clear all paved areas subject to pedestrian and vehicular traffic, including all City of Vaughan driveway entrances, parking lots recreational facilities, joint facilities, firehalls and EMS stations, as identified within the contract. The application of salt to the parking lots after the snow has been cleaned was an activity that Public Works provided in the past. In order to increase the efficiencies and avoid duplication, the application of salt has now been included within this contract.

This tender was advertised in the Vaughan Citizen (Classified Section), Ontario Public Buyers Association and the Bidingo (formerly called Electronic Tender Network – ETN). Tender closed on October 4, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. Thirty-three (33) bid documents were issued and eleven (11) bids were received. Two (2) bids received were deemed non-compliant. In an effort to maintain a consistent service level and in the best interest of the corporation, bidders who did not submit for both areas A & B were not considered. The bid results are as follows:
