1. That Sign Variance Application SV.14-001, Judith Holzman-Cohen, be APPROVED provided that the sign be setback by 1 m from the property line.

Purpose

The applicant is requesting to install a pylon/ground sign to replace the existing sign and move it closer to the property line to make it more visible along Major Mackenzie. The existing sign is currently without an approved permit.

Background - Analysis and Options

Sign By-law Requirements (By-Law 203-92, as amended):

Section 11 – Special Sign Districts

- 11.2 (a) Ground signs for single use buildings shall not exceed 1.5 sq.m. in area per single sign face or 3.0 sq.m. for all faces combined.
- 11.2 (b) Such ground signs shall not exceed 3.0 m in height.

Relationship to Vaughan Vision 2020/Strategic Plan

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council and the necessary resources have been allocated and approved.

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Regional Implications

Region of York Engineering approval is not required for the proposed signs.

Conclusion

The proposed sign is 4.45 sq.m. in size for both sides combined where only 3.0 sq.m. is allowed. Height is at 2.77 metres and conforms to the Sign By-law. Heritage Vaughan committee reviewed and recommended approval of the variance request at their February 19, 2014 meeting.

If Council finds merit in the application a Sign Permit issued by the Building Standards Department is required.
