To the Mayor, Regional Councillors, And City of Vaughan Council Members,

March 22, 2013

In June of 1997 the first Walk to Cure Cancer was organized as a project of the Knights of Columbus of Maple. Our council had just received news that one of our youngest brothers had been diagnosed with cancer - he had a brain tumor and was beginning to undergo chemotherapy. As a way to support that brother and his young family the walk was started and the funds were donated to the Canadian Cancer Society. As a testament that cancer can be beaten that brother is still alive today and continues to attend our events.

Since that first event Vaughan in Motion has directed over \$900,000 toward cancer care in our community. Over \$650,000 was donated to the Canadian Cancer Society for research, treatments, and patient care. Another \$225,000 is being held in trust by the VHCF to be spent strictly on cancer care equipment and/or programs in our new Vaughan Hospital. And \$25,000 was just donated to the Mackenzie Health Foundation for a much needed new MRI unit.

In 2013 we are donating 100% of the pledged monies for our "Walk To Cure Cancer" to the Mackenzie Health Foundation for cancer care in our community. Our Walk is being held on Sunday, April 28<sup>th</sup> at Vaughan Mills; registration is at 9 am and the walk begins at 10 am. Our closing ceremonies happen at noon in the Food court.

We would like to have the week of April 22nd declared "Cancer Awareness Week" with a Vaughan in Motion Flag Raising ceremony similar to last year. Our flag is being stored at the city alongside the flags of Vaughan.

We thank you again for your consideration and look forward to working together again to achieve our goal to cure cancer.
