- 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the appropriate documents.

# Purpose

The purpose of this report is to recommend to Council, based on the evaluation performed by staff, that Stageline Mobile Stage Inc. be awarded the RFP for the supply and delivery of a replacement mobile stage for the City of Vaughan.

### **Background - Analysis and Options**

Purchasing Services advertised RFP14-244 on Biddingo, OPBA and City page on October 2, 2014, with a closing date of November 18, 2014. One addendum was issued to extend the closing date to November 27, 2014.

One (1) potential bidder picked up the document and One (1) compliant bid was received as follow:

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The proposal was reviewed based on the following criteria, which was provided in each of the RFP documents:

Qualifications, Experience, and Scope of Installations	10 points
Submission/Quality of Proposal	10 points
Project Deliverables/Technical Response	60 points
Pricing	20 points
Interview/Presentation	25 points
	Submission/Quality of Proposal Project Deliverables/Technical Response Pricing

Stageline Mobile Stage Inc. met all mandatory requirements and was rated above 80% of the total score per the evaluation criteria. The evaluation committee was satisfied with the product, its functionality, and associated services with the product. Based on the evaluation of the proposal, it is recommended that Stageline Mobile Stage Inc. be retained to supply and deliver one show mobile trailer.

Following the review of the bid and an in person interview with the vendor, several additional options are being recommended by staff for acquisition. These additions are all within the scope of the project and will create flexibility with staging and increase the level of safety while mounting and dismounting the stage. The additional options increase the total cost of the mobile stage to \$158,005 plus any applicable taxes.

The additional optional items proposed to be included in the award of this contract are as follows:

- 1. Item b1 Extension platforms & accessories
- 2. Item b2 Guardrails (Platform Model) / Aluminum
- 3. Item f1 Stage Reversibility
- 4. Item f2 Side Overhang Rigging Beam / Upstage for speakers on all 4 corners
- 5. Item g6 Downstage Windwall Extension
- 6. Item i3 Loading Ramp / Aluminum
- 7. Item e3 Cylinder locks
