## **Contribution to Sustainability**

### **Economic Impact**

Sufficient funds have been budgeted in the Parks Operations Budget to cover the annual costs resulting from the City's procurement of these services from Chantler's Environmental Services Limited.

CRFT2016-01 – Supply, Delivery and Service of Portable Toilets, is funded through the approved operating budget account 6810395.7331. The total cost for work included is within the approved operating budget allocation.

# <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this report is to inform Council that the Town of Newmarket, on behalf of York Region Purchasing Co-operative (YPC), has awarded CRFT2016-01 – Supply, Delivery and Servicing of Portable Toilets for the City of Vaughan for the next five (5) years to Chantler's Environmental Services Limited.

### **Background - Analysis and Options**

The Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations Department oversees maintenance of parks, including maintenance of permitted sports fields. As part of the City's permitted sports field program, the City provides washroom facilities for permit holders to utilize during permitted sporting events. In areas where permanent public washrooms are not in the vicinity, the City

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provides portable washrooms as an alternative to ensure high quality service for field users and permit holders. The City also provides portable toilet rentals for various special events on an as needed basis

Through the cooperation with the Town of Newmarket and the Town of Richmond Hill, the City was able to realize cost savings for the delivery, supply and servicing of portable toilets.

In previous years, the City of Vaughan procured the delivery, supply and servicing of portable toilets on its own. In order to realize best pricing by leveraging economies of scale, the City of Vaughan participated in the York Purchasing Co-operative for Portable Toilets. The City is forecasting a 2% cost savings for regular operations and a 28% cost reduction for special events.

The Town of Newmarket, joined by the Town of Richmond Hill and City of Vaughan, recently awarded CRFT2016-01 – Supply, Delivery and Servicing of Portable Toilets on behalf of the YPC.

The tender was advertised on Biddingo, and the Town of Newmarket City Webpage and closed on Thursday March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 3:00:00pm. A total of six (6) bids were received and results are referenced below:

Chantler's Environmental Services Limited, being the lowest compliant bidder, the company received the award for CRFT2016-01 from the Town of Newmarket, and subsequently the City of Vaughan and Town of Richmond Hill
