Purpose

The purpose of this report is to have Council approve information documents which will assist the members of the Pierre Berton Discovery Centre Fundraising Task Force in carrying out the mandate set-out.

Background - Analysis and Options

The Pierre Berton Discovery Centre Fundraising Task Force has the following mandate:

- 1. To determine the fundraising potential for the proposed Pierre Berton Discovery Centre within not only the Vaughan community, but also extending across Canada.
- 2. To collect pledges (pledges only -no cash) for a 12 month period towards a future capital and operating fundraising campaign for the centre and report back to Council on the overall potential contribution.
- 3. To develop a fundraising strategy for the centre that looks at not only a proposed capital campaign, but also yearly fundraising initiatives to help sustain the centre.

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- 4. To assess and benchmark other cultural centres in their fundraising efforts to determine not only best practice models, but also funding sources and initiatives that may be available to help fund a capital or yearly operating fundraising initiatives.
- 5. To report back to Council within a 12 month period with a Findings Report on the above.

At its meeting of May 29, 2013, the Pierre Berton Discovery Centre Fundraising Task Force recommended the following:

- 1) That the "Interim Report from Pierre Berton Fundraising Task Force Fundraising Strategy", identified as Attachment #1; and The "Pledge Form", identified as Attachment #2, be received; and
- 2) That the City of Vaughan apply to the Jackman Foundation and the J.P. Bickell Foundation and any other granting opportunities and foundations as the Task Force may identify.

In the effort to keep Council updated of the progress of the Task Force, the above noted documents have been produced and have been put forth to Council.

Interim Report from Pierre Berton Fundraising Task Force Fundraising Strategy — For the information of Council

Process:

A sub-committee of the Pierre Berton Fundraising Task Force was established to develop a draft fundraising strategy in accordance with our terms of reference. To date, the sub-committee has met for 2, 2-hour brainstorming and action-development sessions at the Kline House in Kleinburg. Participants in the sub-committee include: Chair, Michael Di Biase, Peter Berton, Berton Woodward, Dave Rutherford, Antony Niro, Anna Bortolus, Angela Palermo, and Mary Reali. We were also joined by Andrea Gyarmati from the City of Vaughan at our first meeting as Angela Palermo's representative.

Subsequently, the draft meeting notes were reviewed with the larger Task Force.

The brainstorming session focused on 5 areas:

- Confirming Fundraising Objectives and Targets
- Exploring Government and Organization Funding Opportunities
- Identifying Possible Financial Supporters Corporations, organizations, and individuals
- Developing a Major Gifts "Pledge" Strategy
- Communications Plan to support Pledge Strategy
